

SECURITY

Definition:

A situation when faculty, staff, or students are involved in an incident involving disruptive, violent, or threatening/stalking behavior, regardless of cause of behavior. Also applies to thefts and acts of vandalism.

Procedure:



1. Faculty, staff, or student decisions should provide for the best possible care, welfare, safety, and security of all those involved.
2. No action should be taken which would place or create risk of injury to any person.
3. Avoid becoming isolated or alone with the source of the disturbance.
4. Dial 9-111 for the Madison Police or contact the **CAMPUS ASSISTANCE CENTER** for help at extension 4444.

• **WHEN IN DOUBT ABOUT THE SITUATION, ALWAYS CALL 9-111.**

Remember:

Use common sense and never take risks that may endanger yourself or others.
